

# Cute Duck Tape Bag

## Supplies

- Duck Tape
- Scissors
- Glass or plastic mat, or cutting mat
- Stapler
- Pencil
- Stencils
- Craft knife



Since Duck Tape comes in several colors, you may choose your favorite for this project.



### 1: Make Duck Tape layers

Stick strips of tape in the desired length on the mat, slightly overlapping them. Here, the strips are 10" long.

### 2: The back of the layers

Turn the layer over and cover with another layer of strips, sticky side on sticky side, overlapping slightly. When you are done, all the sticky portion should be invisible.



### 3: Repeat steps 1 & 2

Make another layer of Duck Tape strips in the same size as the first one for the body of the bag, make two more in a smaller size for the sides and a last one for the bottom of the bag. Cut the tape sheets in the desired length.

### 4: Attaching the base

Place your different pieces in front of you, facing the "outside" of the sheets. Attach one side to the base using Duck Tape. Repeat this step until all sides have been attached to the base.



### 5: « Closing » the bag

Turn your joined pieces to face the « inside », attach the sides and let the top open.

### 6: Making handles

Cut two 16-inch strips of Duck Tape. Fold each strip lengthwise in the middle. Attach the handles to the body of the bag using staples and cover the staples with Duck Tape.



### 7: Decorating the bag

Trace stencil shapes and adhere them to the bag for decoration.
